Each student has the choice to choose between in-person or virtual lessons. As a precaution, I have created a number of safety measures. I encourage you to look over these guidelines when deciding whether you would like to choose in-person or virtual classes. Please let me know your preference, and please feel free to be in touch with any questions!

I will be implementing COVID-19 Guidelines to keep everyone as safe as possible. This includes:

- Students will have the choice of in person or virtual lessons once we reopen. I understand that some people will continue to prefer virtual lessons for health reasons and want to make sure everyone has that option, if needed.
- Everyone will be required to wear a mask.
- Students and teachers will keep a 6-foot minimum distance between them at all times. Instruments cannot be shared.
- I will not be able to touch, tune, put together, or inspect any student instrument. This is in order to eliminate any amount of shared contact
- Stands, chairs, and any common surface will be disinfected between each lesson. This will take a few minutes for each lesson, so keep in mind that your lesson may end a few minutes early so we can take the needed precautions. Please be flexible, we are all in this together.
